

# MLA FORMAT

## Printed Sources

### **Books with one author:**

Author's last name, first name. Name of book. Place of publication: publisher's name, year of publication.

Freedman, Russel. Lincoln A Photobiography. New York: Clarion Books, 1987.

### **Books with two or more authors:**

Author's last name, first name and author's first name last name. Name of book.  
Place of publication: publisher's name, year of publication.

Collier, Christopher and James Lincoln Collier. Pilgrims and Puritans 1620-1676.  
New York: Benchmark Books, 1998

### **Reference book, almanac, encyclopedia without an author listed:**

"Name of article." Title of book or book set. Volume number (if necessary), place of publication: name of publisher, date of publication, pages used.

"Jupiter." World Book Encyclopedia. Vol. 11. Chicago: World Book, Inc., 2001, 198-201

### **Reference book or encyclopedia with an author listed:**

Author's last name, first name. "Name of article." Title of book or book set. volume number. place of publication: publisher, year of publication, pages used.

Miles, Earl J. "Tanzania." New Book of Knowledge. Vol. 17. Connecticut: Grolier, 1998, 16-19.

### **Magazine or newspaper article:**

Author's last name, first name. "Title of article." Title of magazine or newspaper. date of magazine or newspaper: pages used.

Begley, Shaon. "Brave New Monkey." Newsweek. January 22, 2001: 50-52

### **Personal Interview:**

Person's last name, first name. Personal Interview, date of interview.

Brand, Edward. Personal Interview, 9 January 2001.

### A web page

Author(s) name, last name first. Name of page. Date of posting/revision. Date of access  
<electronic address>

### World Book Online (Encyclopedia Online)

Author's name, last name first (if available). "Article title," World Book Online, URL,  
access date.

<<http://www.worldbookonline.com>>, August 27, 1998, Chicago: IBM/World Book,  
Inc.

Note: World Book On-Line articles include citation information at the end of the article.

### Electric Library

After determining the type of information (newspaper article, magazine article, magazine article, book or TV/Radio transcript, use the same format but add at the end of the citation the following: Electric Library <http://www.elibrary.com/education>, date the document was downloaded from Electric Library.

Author's name, last name first (if available). "Article title", copyright date, Grolier

### CD ROM source

Title of CD ROM. CD ROM. place of publication: publisher name, date of publication.

Dictionary of American Biography. CD ROM. New York: Charles Scribner's Sons,  
1997.
